Please see below answers to the questions submitted to catalyze.procurements@thepalladiumgroup.com and received at the bidders conference on January 16, 2024.

No	Question	Answer
1	Is it possible to know about the subcontract budget?	There is not a stated budget range, bidders can propose any budget in line with their proposed technical approach.
2	Can CATALYZE provide a target number of beneficiaries/audience?	CATALYZE will update the RFP with a benchmark or minimum target audience.
3	Will BPJS implement and manage the funds collected?	Yes, BPJS will be the implementing entity that will receive and disburse funds raised.
4	Who will ensure that BPJS is reporting how funds are disbursed?	CATALYZE will coordinate with BPJS to establish regular reporting with both CATALYZE and the selected subcontractor. Bidders will also need to propose a donation reporting system, including reports containing the aggregated donor demographic to BPJS
5	Can we directly interview patients? This is for storytelling purposes in campaign creation.	Bidders should propose an approach to coordinating with BPJS to identify and interview participants in a manner that handles private information responsibly.
6	Can we propose an approach with a consortium of entities under a single parent company?	Yes, consortiums are allowed. Proposals should detail how a consortium will work together.
7	We don't have a UEI, is this required?	Yes. UEIs are required for all vendors doing business with US government funded programs.
